DISTINGUISHING JOB CHARACTERISTICS

Performs multiple tasks related to the admission, maintenance and release of youth to and from the Intervention Center (IC) and/or Detention; monitors cameras and controls access to the secure areas of the Intervention Center. The priority focus of this position is the installation, monitoring, violation and termination of youth on the Court's Electronic Home Monitoring Program. Employee will be assigned to work morning, afternoon, evenings and/or weekends due to 24-hour a-day nature of operation. The position works a rotating schedule that includes two twelve-hour weekend shifts and may include overtime. **The schedule for this specific position is Monday through Friday, 10a-6p, with rotating weekend coverage.**
