Progress in addressing sexual abuse:


- We have experienced an increase in reported allegations within the facility. This increase is reflected due to, in part, in the acceptance of female residents on behalf of the Department of Youth Services. Accepting female residents from all Ohio counties has broadened our population in terms of residents at potential risk of victimization and abusiveness.
 - Increased security staff to comply with required ratios
 - Installed Paytel phone system to provide youth with unimpeded access to family, attorneys, and third party reporting method.
 - Initiated facility upgrades including, but not limited to, 22 additional cameras, increase in video storage capabilities, upgrade locks, and installed additional observation mirrors.
 - Initiated Memorandum of Understanding for victim services, third party reporting, interpreter services, and criminal investigations.
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(c) The report shall be approved by agency head and made readily available to the public through its website.
